

Case Study: A Livelink to SharePoint Migration

Client Background

A mid-major energy Client with offices across North America, with use of Livelink for over 5+ years, resulting in over 2,000,000 documents company wide. Heaviest business area usage represented by Engineering, Financial/Audit and Regulatory departments.

Company had experienced several mergers over the past ten years which had led to multiple instances of Livelink (different versions), SharePoint and several other smaller EDRMS Systems with differing structures, taxonomies (organization), and security models. Governance, management and support of these environments proved to be a significant challenge for this Client.

Economic priorities were the key driver for Company to look to reduce costs on non-essential services where high operating costs and lower oil prices were the new reality. An IT committee was formed to review opportunities for consolidation and cost savings. It was identified that consolidating ECM platforms could result in potential savings of \$800,000 USD per annum on licensing and over \$2,500,000 USD per annum on IT staffing to support multiple EDRMS (primarily Livelink and SharePoint 2010). Furthermore a decision was made to outsource SharePoint support to realize further savings and support the organization wide objective of reducing non-op costs.

Project Details

Business Case Assessment and Project Approvals

We first performed a fit gap assessment of Livelink and SharePoint.

Producing a high level plan to IT committee recommending and supporting the **business case** for the feasibility to decommission Livelink. Resulted in Client decision to proceed with the project to migrate from Livelink to SharePoint.

Project Planning and Analysis

Provided input and support to IT to define a **project plan and strategy for migrations**. Delivered **architectural suggestions** for optimization of environments for migration considerations and sizing.

Assisted IT in **defining the detailed migration plan** and master design specification for migrations. Facilitated analysis and steering committee signoff on the master design specification:

- Definition of source and destination mappings for structures
- Identification of system wide metadata mappings (company-wide Content Types) and recommendations for migration methodology to SharePoint
- Definition of new organizational permissions structure and mapping roles in SharePoint
- Developed mechanism to support historical links (a high priority requirement)

Migrations and Closeouts

Assisted IT providing advisement and analysis services on migration groups as required. Provided the ECM Wise Migration Tool Suite for IT to perform migrations from Livelink to SharePoint and Network drives. Tool supported the master design specification and specific migration area configuration needs.

Our development team worked with IT to optimize and address specific migration needs. Our tools provided auditable logs of all migration activities as proof of migration Assisted Livelink team to decommission Livelink servers and retired environments.



Conclusion and Benefits

The ECM Wise Migration Tool Suite and Advisory services team enabled the Project Team to facilitate successful migrations - transferring the desired content to SharePoint, and preserving key metadata (created and modified dates, original paths, and important key business category attributes).

Audit logs were stored as proof of migration for all migration content and facilitated the validation of each migration group.



Furthermore our **unmetered migration** model allowed large volume document migrations at a low fixed cost which further enhanced project return on investment for the Client.

Client achieved final state of **Livelink Retirement** to realize significant licensing and labour costs savings and allowed for one single EDRMS repository (reducing user confusion).
